<b>1</b>	<b>Apologies for absence</b> Glyn Thomas	
<b>2</b>	<b>Declaration of Interests</b> None	
<b>3</b>	<b>Acceptance of Minutes 12<sup>th</sup> July 2005</b> These were agreed	
<b>4</b>	<b>Streetlight repairs, replacement &amp; maintenance</b>  AM reported that the electricity company has refused to pay for repairs to the damaged street light in Pitchcott Road.  RB reported a street light not functioning outside 4 The Pightle  Councillors decided to look at the budget with a view to either replacing just the one light in Pitchcott Road at a cost of £1,000 or 3 lights at a reduced cost of £750 each.	<b>AM</b>
<b>5</b>	<b>Update on Pavilion survey &amp; renovation</b>  AM reported that a positive reaction had been received from all parties to the survey, but a decision on action was deferred until the Recreation Ground Committee meet on Monday 19 September 2005.  AM also reported that Steve Hunt had satisfactorily completed some remedial repair work.  AM said that major expenditure cannot be considered until the Church Farm development has been commenced and commitments made by the developers.	
<b>6</b>	<b>Reading Room furniture</b>  RB showed Councillors one chair that had recently been refurbished at a cost of £120. Total cost of refurbishing all 10 chairs is therefore £1,200. All agreed to proceed, subject to budget being available.	
<b>7</b>	<b>Accounts to date</b>  Deferred awaiting briefing from the Clerk  With regard to the Global insurance policy for the Rec' AM reported that the Parish Council had now reviewed the cover against the current inventory and provided a savings of approximately £500 had been achieved.  It was agreed that all clubs using the Recreation Ground should be asked to reconfirm their commitment to paying a share of the running costs of the ground.	
<b>8</b>	<b>Update on Highway issues</b>  Agreed that installation of a pavement should be requested between The Pightle and	<b>GT</b>

the Recreation Ground on road safety grounds.

Highways to be advised that the footpath between Baulk Road and Whitchurch needs resurfacing.

AM noted that we are awaiting a report on all footpaths from Bucks County Council
