They were advised that the issues raised would be discussed during the Council meeting and at the next Design & Location group meeting.

<b>2 Declaration of interest in items on the agenda</b> None	
<b>3 Acceptance of minutes of meeting held on 13 May 2008</b> These were agreed and signed by the Chairman.	
<b>4 Matters arising not covered by the agenda</b> None.	
<b>5 To agree Accounts to end June 2008</b> The Clerk reported on the accounts which were agreed.	
<b>6 To agree the Cheque run for June/July 2008</b> The cheque run was approved.	
<b>7 To update on Pavilion Project</b> Consideration was given to a third party outsider giving professional input as to the best location. It was agreed that this should be discussed at the next working group meeting. Cllrs to email Cllr Peeters their availability for such a meeting over the next 4 weeks. Quotes were being sought for design, bill of materials and tender documents. Cllr Ball reported that 3 more members had joined the Funding group. Details of forthcoming events was on the website.	
<b>8 Update on Church Lane Pump Wall</b> The Clerk had obtained 3 quotes. It was agreed to proceed with the £583 quote and the Clerk would enquire about lime mortar. It was agreed that the stones should be moved to the green.	The Clerk

**9 Update on Map Location**

**10 Update on Speeding Issues**

Cllr Nicholls reported on the NAG meeting he had attended on 24 June. Cllrs discussed sharing the cost of the speeding kit with other parishes and it was agreed to proceed as a minority shareholder with ownership of the kit by another parish.

**11 Update on Farm Watch**

Cllr Nicholls reported that there had been a huge rise in the number of thefts from farms and advised that NAG were trying to reinstate Farm Watch.

**12 To update on ROSPA**

The Clerk reported that the play area has been passed by ROSPA with a few low risk items. It was agreed to defer taking any action until a decision had been made regarding the location of the Pavilion.

**13 To decide on North Bucks Parishes Planning Consortium**

Cllr Peeters reported on the Planning Consortium and it was agreed not to join at the moment as the Parish would not be directly affected.

**14 To decide on request for use of Football Pitch**

Cllr Ball reported that he had turned down a request from the Bedgrove Dynamos due to the condition of the pitch.

**15 To decide on purchase of Mini-Goal**

Council decided to purchase a Mini-Goal.
