1. Roger B welcomed the **new members** of the Group – Mary and Lynn. Sally has also agreed to join the Group, but was unable to attend this Meeting.
2. The **Note of Funding Group** Meeting No 6 on 27.05.08 was approved for circulation. The proceeds of the Book Sale and Farm Teas (item 2) have been banked, and a detailed breakdown was agreed to be unnecessary.
3. Roger B congratulated Mary on her successful **bicycle ride** from Oving, Bucks to Oving, West Sussex. A total of £695 in sponsorship was raised towards the Fund, and has now been banked.
4. There was a discussion about **future events**.
 - The salsa dance night at Quanton is being organised by Adrian, Stephen and their partners. Enquiries are being made about a band and an instructor. It is envisaged that food and drinks will be provided on a similar basis to the Race Night. A date has yet to be agreed, but a Saturday in October is being considered, subject to availability of Quanton Memorial Hall.
 - Brenda Ball is planning a sponsored run in the autumn, covering all the roads of Oving.
 - Susan reported that Roger H is continuing discussions with Ross Beattie, who is kindly negotiating the purchase of a brand new car from Keith Garages, to be raffled at the Valentine's Ball next February. A substantial number of tickets will need to be sold at a price yet to be decided. The target is to make a profit of £5,000, and potential markets for ticket sales will need to be identified. Lynn has a friend who has some experience in this area, and agreed to make enquiries about licences, printing, selling locations and so on.
 - Mary is planning an evening of carols, mince pies and mulled wine at Ground Farm Barn during the week before Christmas. She will be inviting the All Saints Choir to lead the singing.

5. Roger B reported that he had received an acknowledgement of the **WRG Communities Challenge Application**, and that he will be advised during July whether it has reached the second stage of the process.
